The process is simple.

If you are young (18-45 years old), healthy and you want to give your own answer to the fear and threat of a very difficult disease like cancer, then be a marrow donor.

Just fill out the volunteer application form and give mouth swab (at a special health center). With your registration to the National and Global Bone Marrow Registry, the moment you are found compatible with a patient, with just a few cells from your blood, you can give life to a child or some of your peers.

Just remember that the most powerful cancer drug is you!
